

Reflecting on Reconciliation

Amahoro Africa is launching a year-long season of reflection on the Gospel of Reconciliation and you are part of the first conversation. This conversation will feature dialogue, learning, story telling and shared travel exposing the experience of reconciliation in Africa.

We find great words of challenge in the Bible about being a reconciling community that is marked by forgiveness, restoration, healing and embracing one another. We find contexts in Africa that present great challenges to living out the reconciling imperatives we, as followers of Jesus, have been charged with embodying. Amahoro Africa wants to sponsor a sustained conversation on the dynamics of reconciliation, bringing together the words of Scripture with the people and places of Africa to open the door for deep reflection and shared learning.

Our hope is that at the end of the year we will have learned more from our time of meditation on Biblical voices on issues of reconciliation, that we will have discovered places across Africa where the truths of reconciliation are being incarnated and that we will together have our imaginations ignited with new ideas on how to live out the reconciling message of Jesus in local African communities in the years to come.
